Please join us, the Derman Family and the North Quadra Community Association in commemorating Vic Derman's legacy on Canada's Parks Day, July 15th, the year of


Canada's 150th Birthday! Vic Derman Park is a small, natural area on Christmas Hill, adjacent to the Swan Lake Christmas Hill Nature Sanctuary (just south of Roger's elementary school). Councilor Derman was instrumental in securing these and other protected areas on Christmas Hill.

Attendees are encouraged to walk, bike, hike or bus to honour Vic Derman's commitment to alternative transportation and the environment. Park at the Saanich Municpal Hall or the Swan Lake Nature House parking lot and walk up Christmas Hill either up Rainbow Street or via Nelthorpe (approximately 30 minutes or 1.5 km). Please see map for suggested routes.

Access Vic Derman Park via Rainbow Street, Rogers Way, or through the Swan Lake Christmas Hill Nature sanctuary off of Woodhall Drive or Nelthorpe Street.

Light refreshments will be served after the dedication ceremony.

We suggest parking at the Swan Lake **Nature House** parking lot and walk up **Christmas Hill** either up Rainbow street or via Nelthorpe (approximately 30 minutes or 1.5 km). Overflow parking also available on **Nelthorpe Street**
